FATHER SCOTT'S SHARING SPOT

A Message from Father Scott VanDerveer, Pastor at St. Mary's Church



Dear Parish Family,

At the Easter Vigil on April 8, we will welcome a number of new Catholics into our faith. You may have seen them at Mass and not known that they were not yet fully initiated into our faith, so I'd like to take a few moments to introduce you to them so you can know their sacred stories.

Cindy Edgerly worked for 30 years at Verizon on Glen Street and gave retiring to Florida a try for a few years before the draw to be with her grandchildren brought her back home. She had was born here and raised in Hudson Falls to a family that didn't really have much of a church practice. She had been baptized Methodist but wasn't deeply connected to the church of her childhood. For years now Cindy has been drawn to the Catholic faith and has had becoming Catholic in the back of her mind. In the past two years, Cindy has developed a hunger for the Eucharist that she could no longer ignore. Last summer she inquired about the process to become Catholic and has been a committed member of the group preparing for the "Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults" (RCIA) for the past six months. Cindy is "all in" and knows in her heart that with us is right where she belongs. On April 8, Cindy will be Confirmed as a Catholic and satisfy her longtime hunger by receiving the Eucharist for the first time.

The journey of **Rojana** (**Ro**) **Padron** began halfway around the world in her Asia and involves a mixing of cultures and traditions beyond anything you may have ever imagined. Ro was raised Buddhist in Cambodia, but in her youth when her family came to the USA, it was an Episcopalian church that sponsored their immigration.

Despite their love of the ways of Buddhism, out of gratitude for what that faith community had done and appreciation for the beauty of their liturgy, Ro and her whole family were baptized Episcopalian.

Later, Ro met and married Jorge, whose family was from Cuba and was Catholic. Imagine now that an Episcopalian-Buddhist Cambodian-American was marrying a Catholic Cuban-American from NYC! Over the years, Ro and Jorge regularly attended Masses with his family. The closeness of the practice to the ways of the Episcopal church made it a comfortable fit for Ro. Then in October 2021, Ro and Jorge relocated themselves and their kids – Reagan and Harry - up to Glens Falls near their beloved Adirondacks. Because Omicron was rampant at that time, their first experience of St. Mary's was not in person, but on the livestream. But they knew they had found their home. "Even my Cambodian parents felt so connected when they watched Mass from St. Mary's with us," she said.

Ro knew the time had come for her to become Catholic. Her journey stoked the embers of Jorge's faith and caused the two of them to encourage Reagan and Harry to be baptized. So now, at the Easter Vigil in three weeks, Ro will receive the Eucharist for the first time and be confirmed, while Harry and Reagan will be baptized and join with their Mom and Dad and all of us at the Eucharistic table.

Isn't it moving to hear the ways that God is at work in the lives of people who are becoming Catholic? I hope you can join us on April 8 at 8 PM to witness the blessed initiation of Cindy, Ro, Reagan & Harry at the Easter Vigil.


