

A Message from Father Scott VanDerveer, Pastor at St. Mary's Church

Dear Parish Family,

Many people have commented to me that a recent Gospel and homily about showing mercy by letting our foot off the gas on our judgment of others has stayed with them these past few weeks. This vice affects me and **SO MANY** of us... it is a rare person who doesn't have a struggle in this area. We're all united in wrestling with the demon of judging others.

I recently came across a prayer that strikes me as a good one for all of us who need God's help in dropping our judgments. See if it speaks to you...

Heavenly Father, help us remember that the jerk who cut us off in traffic last night is a single mother who worked nine hours that day and is rushing home to cook dinner, help with homework, do the laundry and spend a few precious moments with her children. And please remind us, Lord, that the scary looking bum, begging for money in the same spot every day (who really ought to get a job!) is a slave to addictions that we can only imagine in our worst nightmares.

Oh Lord, help us to remember that the mature couple walking annoyingly slowly through the store aisles and blocking our shopping progress are savoring this moment, knowing that, based on the biopsy report she got back last week, this will be the last year that they go shopping together.

Heavenly Father, remind us each day that of all the gifts you give us... the greatest gift is love. It is not enough to share that love with those we hold dear. Open our hearts not to just those that are close to us, but to all humanity. Let us be slow to judge and quick to forgive, show patience, empathy and love.
