#### **Father Scott's Sharing Spot**

A Message from Father Scott VanDerveer, Pastor at St. Mary's Church



Dear Parish Family,

Each one of us has a certain cause that captures our heart. Some causes seem to choose us. One example of those for me, as many of you know, is adoption. I know first-hand that it provides a "win - win - win" for childless couples, children and for those dealing with crisis pregnancies. Another cause that has chosen me is the care for the environment. I was born on Earth Day, so I feel that God gave me a special calling to care for the earth and to encourage others to have reverence for creation.

The following suggestions have had a powerful influence on me and cause me to be careful in the way I use and discard things. Perhaps some of them will speak to you, too.

See the Earth as a mother. Recognize a duty to care for her. Terms like "Mother Nature" are meant to remind us that the Earth is alive. Sitting in quiet in the grass can help you to realize how many forms of life God has given us in every square inch of earth. Each comes from God and each is precious.

Say grace before you eat, recognizing that our nourishment comes from the earth.

Reminding ourselves that we would be nothing and have nothing without God helps us treat God better...and the earth better, too.

# Recognize that humans would have nowhere to live if we lost the earth.

We can't throw away our garbage because there is no "away." Where else would it go but in the ground... in the ocean... or burnt up into toxic smoke? Recycling allows us to avoid pretending that throw "away" garbage on our round planet. We need to see recycling as a spiritual practice, because it is. Learn what items the local Transfer Station in your town accepts.

Then check out the "How 2 Recycle website" https://how2recycle.info/ to see the long list of items that can't be put in regular recycling but can be dropped off at a nearby hardware store. You'll be surprised how many things don't belong in the garbage.

In making decisions, consider the 7th Generation away from now and ask if your choice will help or harm them. We exist because our ancestors made decisions that allowed us to one day flourish. We owe our unborn grandchildren and great-great-great grandchildren the same gift. Join the community Climate Action walk on Sunday, May 8 at 1 PM, from City Park up Glen Street to Crandall Park. We want our future descendants to see our faces in the old pictures of events from before they were born that were intended to make the world a better, more livable place for them.

This earth does so much to support our lives.

Spring is the perfect time to see that in action.

The little things we do can make a big difference.

Show your gratitude to God by caring for

God's gift to us – our beloved planet Earth.


