Father Scott's Sharing Spot

A Message from Father Scott VanDerveer, Pastor at St. Mary's Church



Dear Parish Family,

Last week I told you about the Care Portal, the exciting new way for our parishioners to serve our community by providing resources and elbow grease to help keep kids with their families and out of the foster care system. The background of this ministry is important to know.

This summer, in advance of the launch of the Care Portal locally, our Volunteer Coordinator Alison Hancock connected with Justice for Orphans (JFO), the Albany grassroots organization that brought the Care Portal to the North Country. When it began, JFO's original goal was to help children whose parents had died and to advocate for adoption for children of unplanned pregnancies. In time, JFO realized the tremendous need to support the sagging foster care system, in which a lot of the children JFO aims to help are being cared for. In researching how they could help, JFO learned some stunning facts.

Every year, there are thousands of calls to the county's Child Protective Services Office.

Most of those calls came from a family in hardship. For example, there were repeated instances of mothers who had been living in a domestic violence shelter who were now rebuilding their life without their abusive spouse and who wanted their kids back from foster care, but lacked much of what they needed to rebuild a household from scratch.

JFO discovered that the #1 item parents in that kind of situation needed were kids' beds, since kids can't leave foster care without a bed to sleep in. Many kids in underprivileged homes sleep on air mattresses on the floor. Other mothers were not able to bring their babies home from the maternity ward of the hospital because they lacked a car seat, so the child had to be brought to a foster family instead.

One family's home had been vandalized and they had garbage bags where their windows were broken. The kids' mom slept on couch downstairs so she could leap to defend her children in case of home invasion. Their social worker saw the situation and knew that the house needed replacement windows in order for the kids to live there safely.

In our 8-county region in 2023, 2,200 children were aided through the Care Portal – and 5,200 have been aided since 2018! In just two months, St. Mary's parishioners have already provided a bed safety device for a local special needs child and delivered and donated the linens and assembled five kids' beds (donated by an Albany car dealer), which allowed two local families to remain together and reunited a third family. How exciting!

Is this the involvement you have been waiting for? If so, we need:
