Father Scott's Sharing Spot

A Message from Father Scott VanDerveer, Pastor at St. Mary's Church



Dear Parish Family,

Last week I introduced the four pillars of Catholic Social Teaching: (1) Care for the Common Good; (2) Upholding the Dignity of every Human Person; (3) Subsidiarity; and (4) Solidarity. Today we can take a closer look at the first one: the call to promote the **common good**, which is central to the Gospel and to building the kind of community Jesus envisioned.

The common good refers to those conditions in society that allow all people—not just a few—to reach their full potential. It's not about giving everyone the same things, but about ensuring that each person has access to the essentials they need to thrive. In other words, it's not just about me or you—it's about us.

Care for the common good is behind the concept of schools. Every community sets aside money and space so the local children have a place to learn and grow. That's exactly why we work so hard to maintain our **parish Catholic school ministry at SMA**. When we support Catholic education, we're investing in the formation of young people who will carry these Gospel values into the world. A Catholic school doesn't just serve its students—it blesses the whole community by raising up leaders with hearts for justice, truth, and compassion. Many of the greatest sponsors of SMA are not people with kids or grandkids in the school, but people who believe in forming the next generation in virtue and hope. That's the common good.

When we support things like **public libraries**, **clean parks**, and **safe neighborhoods**, we are living out this teaching. These are resources that benefit the whole community—especially those who may not have those things at home. A public library doesn't just offer books; it provides access to knowledge, technology, warmth in the winter, and cool in the summer. Parks give families a place to play, seniors a space to walk, and neighbors a chance to gather. When we advocate for clean streets and safe corners, we're standing up for the dignity and well-being of our fellow citizens. Let's commit to being people who think not just about what's best for us, but what's best for everyone. That's how we live the Gospel—not just in our pews, but in our parks, our schools, and our streets.

Together, let's build a community where all can flourish. That's the common good and our Catholic calling.
