make us one!


From the many we are, Lord,



ATTENTION SNOWBIRDS WITH CHURCH ENVELOPES:

Please inform us 2 ½ months before your departure so we can STOP your envelopes while you are gone.

The Post Office will not forward the envelope packets and they bounce back to the parish with a hefty postage due fee. The envelope company prints the envelopes as soon a the previous batch is mailed which is the reason for the long notice time.

Other options to consider

- Stop using envelopes and simply write your parish ID number in the memo area of your check (it is the same as the number on your envelopes)
- 2) Switch to e-giving. It is easy and convenient.
