
Enjoy the humor below—and thank you for all that you do to live your faith and support our parish family.


To make it possible for everyone to attend Church next Sunday, we are going to have a special "No Excuse Sunday":

- 12. We will provide hearing aids for those who can't hear the preacher and cotton for those who say he is too darn loud.


