A Message from Father Scott VanDerveer, Pastor at St. Mary's Church



Dear Parish Family,

I walked into the hospital recently and was greeted by a patient who seemed to know me incredibly well, but I was unable to place him. He was speaking to me as if he were a member of the parish, but his face was completely unfamiliar to me.

And then it came up in the conversation that he is a member of our Virtual Parish through our Livestream ministry, and he comes from a very special corner of the Virtual Parish – he is a resident at the Glen. He is proud to be an active member of our community, though he is unknown to many of us.

Earlier this year, one of our parishioners, Cathy Vesterby, whose mother is a resident of the Glen, proposed that we could arrange to have a weekly virtual liturgy for the residents there. It would involve watching the livestream of the weekend Mass on a large screen at the Glen; assembling the group that attended in a seating arrangement that was reminiscent of the church, and providing communion for everyone present at the same time the church assembly was receiving communion on the livestream. There is no easy way to have all of these residents, many of whom do not drive, come each week to St. Mary's, so this was an excellent accommodation. This very much followed the protocols we had during the pandemic, so I didn't see any real drawback. What made it even better is that the Cathy volunteered to be the one to take responsibility for it each week and to recruit other volunteers to join her in the effort. This was a pastor's dream come true!

I recently received an email from one of our parishioners who has been present for many of these liturgies expressing what a blessing this kernel of an idea had become as it bloomed.

"I just wanted to convey to you how great the outreach at The Glen via the Monday livestream is! Cathy is doing a fabulous job with so many details. Judy is great with the tech, Sharon, Paul, Mark all are so welcoming, reverent and have been a consistent presence that the people have come to know and seek. They thank us as they leave after Mass! I can see the friendships being made as people are comfortable in their faith community. The residents are prayerful, they sing and are engaged. Some family members join them. You may have heard all this before, but I felt called to relay what a great ministry this project is – there is so much to say! There have been 30+ people the last two weeks! Cathy has put so much into this project and it is so wonderful to see its fruit. They look forward to celebrating with you every week! – Peace and blessings, Maria"

There is no possible way for us to ever tally up all the ways St. Mary's parishioners make a positive impact on the larger community around us... but God sees all of it. May God, who has begun this good work at the Glen, bring it, week by week, to fulfillment.
