#### A Message from Father Scott VanDerveer, Pastor at St. Mary's Church



Dear Parish Family,

This week I sent a check for \$6,231 from our parish to the WAIT House. This meaningful amount represented 10% of all of our collections (in envelopes, e-giving contributions and cash placed in the basket) from the First Weekend of Lent (March 8/9) through the Fifth Weekend (April 12/13). In making this sacrifice, we are following the ancient tradition of "giving alms" during Lent to those in need and making a difference in the lives of the young people served by the WAIT House.

Here is a letter I received from Jason McLaughlin, the Executive Director.

Dear Members of the St. Mary's Church Congregation,

On behalf of the entire team at WAIT House, I want to extend our most sincere gratitude for your incredible generosity and ongoing support of our mission to serve youth in crisis in the Glens Falls community.

I was incredibly honored to have the opportunity to speak with your congregation during my (February) visit. It was a true privilege to stand before such a warm, welcoming, and engaged community to share the story of WAIT House, our mission, and the challenges facing the youth in our care. Your openness, attentiveness, and thoughtful questions deeply moved me. I could feel the sincerity in the room, and I left feeling not only encouraged, but uplifted by your collective spirit.

Your willingness to come together, listen and reflect on the realities of youth human trafficking gave our work and the voices of those we serve the platform and respect they deserve. It is through communities like yours, that change truly begins to take root.

Your contributions, both material and spiritual, have had a direct impact on the young people who come through our doors seeking shelter, safety, and a sense of belonging. The outpouring of support from the congregation has been truly heartfelt and emotional for me personally. Your thoughtful outreach and each act of kindness from your congregation helps us meet our youth with dignity and compassion at a time when they need it most.




