#### **Father Scott's Sharing Spot**

#### A Message from Father Scott VanDerveer, Pastor at St. Mary's Church



Dear Parish Family,

One of the greatest gifts you can give your family is to make some of your funeral plans ahead of time. It may feel strange to think about your own funeral, but pre-planning is really an act of love. It allows you to share your wishes, to lighten the burden on your loved ones, and to make sure your funeral reflects your faith.

Many people know about pre-planning with a funeral director and paying the cost for preparation and burial, but they never get around to actually doing it. Choosing a local funeral home and making an appointment with them is wonderful first step. If you don't yet have a cemetery plot in which you will be buried, making an appointment with Gary Patton in our Cemetery Office (or with the administrator of the cemetery of your choice) is the second step of this process. The third step is to think about the kind of celebration you want to plan at the time of your passing.

#### Why pre-plan?

When someone dies, families are often asked to make dozens of decisions in just a few days. Choosing readings, music, and roles for family members can feel overwhelming when hearts are heavy with grief. Pre-planning removes that weight. It lets your family know what you want, while still leaving them the freedom to add their own touches.

#### What can be chosen in advance? You can select:

- Readings from Scripture that have been meaningful in your life.
- **Hymns** that capture your faith and devotion.
- Preferences for burial or cremation.
- People you'd like to involve (readers, gift bearers, etc.), as you wish.

You don't need to plan every detail, but even noting one or two preferences can make a huge difference.

#### Where are the plans kept?

Families keep a copy with their own important documents and also share a copy of these plans with their funeral director. That way, when the time comes, the parish and funeral home can coordinate with confidence and clarity.

#### A spiritual act of trust


Pre-planning isn't just practical—it's also a spiritual act. By preparing your funeral, you are expressing your faith in the Resurrection and your trust in God's promises. You are also choosing to bless your family with peace, sparing them from uncertainty in their time of sorrow.

#### **Getting** started

If you'd like to begin this process, the parish is ready to walk with you. We can provide planning materials, sit down with you to discuss options, and help you keep your wishes safely on file. You can do as much or as little as you like now, and update your choices at any time.

Thinking about our own funeral may not be easy, but it can be deeply freeing. It allows us to live with confidence that, when our earthly journey ends, the Church will pray us home with beauty and dignity.




