Father Scott's Sharing Spot

A Message from Father Scott VanDerveer, Pastor at St. Mary's Church



Dear Parish Family,

Here is the last installment of my friend and mentor Peter's list of brainstormed Works of Mercy based on the Church's traditional list of works. See if one or two of these make you stop and think.

Bear wrongs patiently.

- Frustrated with someone? Step away from the situation, take a few deep breaths, say the Our Father and ask God for patience.
- When hurt by someone, remember that you have hurt others in the past, as well.
- Be more patient with your own issues and problems.
- Give up perfectionism; even perfect people get criticized. No human escapes it.

Pray for the living and the dead.

- Make a prayer list of people that you know are sick and pray for them every day.
- Pray for your friends and relatives who have died.
- If you hear about something tragic or sad on the news, pray for the people involved.
- When you hear a siren or pass an ambulance say a prayer.
- Pray for our seminarians, priests, sisters, brothers and missionaries.
- Request a Mass intention for someone going through a tough time.
- Keep your own book or list of prayer intentions writing names of those who need your prayer.
- Entrust your own concerns to God. See prayer as a tactic for facing any problem.

Care for Creation.

- See the Earth as a mother. Recognize a duty to care for her.
- Recognize that humans would have nowhere to live if we lost the earth.
- In making decisions, consider the 7th Generation away from now and ask if your choice will help or harm them.
- Recognize recycling as a spiritual practice, because it is.
- Say grace before you eat, recognizing that our nourishment comes from the earth.

The Year of Mercy Jubilee concludes in November, but our practice of the acts of mercy must be perpetual. After all, each one of us depends on mercy from God and each other simply to survive.






