Father Scott's Sharing Spot

A Message from Father Scott VanDerveer, Pastor at St. Mary's Church



Dear Parish Family,

November is always a sacred time to remember loved ones who have died and to consider that all of us are pilgrims, making our way through the chapters of life toward a life to come with God in heaven.

I wanted to spend the weeks leading up to our annual celebration of All Saints and All Souls writing a bit about one of the most beautiful parts of being Catholic – when we gather to commend a loved one to the mercy of God. On the day of a Catholic funeral, every Catholic present is grateful to God for their faith (and everyone else who is there is wishing they were Catholic, at least for that day).

A Catholic funeral is not just a farewell. It is a beautiful prayer of the Church that holds together grief, gratitude, and hope. It is the most sacred way we, as Catholics, face the mystery of death. The Church teaches that a funeral has three purposes. First, we pray for the soul of the one who has died, entrusting them to God's mercy and asking that the Lord welcome them into eternal life. Second, the funeral strengthens and consoles the grieving family, surrounding them with the prayers and presence of their parish community. Third, it proclaims our faith in Jesus' victory over death and his promise that we, too, will share in the Resurrection.


A Catholic funeral has traditionally been made up of three parts:

- 1. **The Vigil (Wake)** A time of prayer, remembrance, and keeping watch with the family. This is often a very personal gathering, where stories and memories are freely shared, and where the Church prays the Rosary or other Scripture-based prayers for the deceased.
- 2. **The Funeral Mass** The central liturgy of Christian burial. Here we gather at the altar to offer the greatest prayer we can: the Eucharist. Surrounded by Scripture, song, and sacrament, the family brings their loved one to the Lord, who first gave them the gift of life. In the homily, the priest or deacon recalls the person's life in the light of God's Word. At the heart of it all, we entrust our beloved dead to Christ, who shows us that God's love conquers everything even death itself.
- 3. **The Committal (Burial or Interment)** The final act of farewell at the cemetery or mausoleum. Here, the body is laid to rest, and we together begin to ritually imagine how we will go forward with the help of God and the love of our family and friends.

Taken together, these moments give us space to grieve honestly, to remember lovingly, and to hope confidently. Catholic funerals are not only rituals of sadness, but also proclamations of love. They assure us that, even in death, life is changed, not ended.

In the weeks ahead, this series will walk through practical steps of planning a Catholic funeral—whether you are making decisions at the time of a loved one's passing or thoughtfully preparing your own funeral in advance. My prayer is that these reflections will help you to see the beauty of the Church's tradition and the comfort it can bring in a difficult time.
