Father Scott's Sharing Spot

A Message from Father Scott VanDerveer, Pastor at St. Mary's Church



Dear Parish Family,

I wanted to spend the weeks leading up to our annual celebration of All Saints and All Souls writing a bit about one of the most beautiful parts of being Catholic – when we gather to commend a loved one to the mercy of God.

The loss of a loved one is one of the hardest moments in life. In the swirl of emotions, it can feel overwhelming to know what to do first. The good news is that you are not alone. The Church, along with the funeral home, walks closely with families to guide each step.

Who to call first

When a death occurs, the first practical call is usually to the funeral home. Funeral directors know how to handle the immediate logistics, whether the death happens at home, in the hospital, or in a nursing facility. One of their very first questions will be: "What church will you be working with?" This is where you simply give the name of your parish. From there, the funeral home and parish staff work together to coordinate dates, times, and details.

The parish's role

As soon as we receive word, our parish reaches out to support you. We schedule a meeting with your family—usually within a day or two—to plan the funeral liturgy and to surround you with the care of the Church.

The planning meeting

This meeting is gentle and conversational. Two things happen at once:

- 1. **Support** We begin by offering compassion, listening to stories about your loved one, and getting to know the person you are grieving. This is not just "planning paperwork"—it's a moment to share and remember together.
- 2. Liturgical Planning We guide you through the choices for the funeral service: readings from Scripture, hymns, and the participation of family and friends. Some families come with clear preferences; others feel too burdened to make decisions. Both approaches are welcome. If you prefer, the parish is happy to select everything for you. The important thing is that the funeral truly honors your loved one and brings peace to your family.

The roles of family and friends

Families often like to include children, grandchildren, or close friends in the funeral Mass. They may read the Scripture passages, bring up the gifts of bread and wine, or offer the prayers of intercession. These small acts of participation can mean a great deal, but they are always optional. If no one feels able to take on a role, parish volunteers step in with love.

The gift of being carried

In a time of grief, even simple decisions can feel like too much. That is why the parish offers both guidance and freedom: you are invited to personalize the liturgy, but never pressured. If you only want to say, "Father, please just do what you think is best," that is perfectly acceptable.

The Catholic funeral is a work of love carried out by the whole community. You do not have to walk this path alone.
