Father Scott's Sharing Spot

A Message from Father Scott VanDerveer, Pastor at St. Mary's Church



Dear Parish Family,

What a joy it is to witness Hailey and Stephen join Joseph, Ed, Amyah and Paige being fully initiated into the Catholic faith at the **Easter Vigil**. Having six new fully initiated members this year has been tremendously uplifting for us all.

We have been blessed to have new Catholics being in initiated through our parish every year, since before I arrived here in 2021. Interestingly, this is not unique to St. Mary's. An increase in the number of adult women and men seeking the Sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation has been noticed across our Diocese and in other parts of the world, as well. At our Cathedral in Albany back on the first Sunday of Lent in March, there were 94 catechumens at the Rite of Election, double that of the past few years.

It is well known that the Catholic Church in France and most of Western Europe has been anemic, so to speak, for at least two generations. But in 2024, over 7,000 adults entered the Church in France during last year's Easter Vigil. The Holy Spirit is truly at work!

What is happening, we wonder? Many point to a deep longing for meaning in an increasingly complex world. Others see the lasting effects of the pandemic, which led many to re-evaluate their lives and seek a stronger spiritual foundation. For some, the Church has become a place of community and belonging in a world that often feels isolating.

This growth presents both an opportunity and a challenge for us as a faith community. With more catechumens, we are called to walk alongside them in faith, offering support, formation, and prayer. It is also an invitation for each of us to deepen our own faith and discipleship, as we witness the beauty of conversion and renewal in Christ.

As we rejoice this Easter, let us give thanks for this outpouring of grace and commit ourselves living lives radiant with virtue, that cannot help but attract the attention of our neighbors. If you know someone seeking faith, encourage them. If you feel called to help in our OCIA ministry, let us know. The harvest is abundant, and together, we can share in the joy of welcoming new sisters and brothers into the family of God.
