

Father Scott's Sharing Spot

A Message from Father Scott VanDerveer, Pastor at St. Mary's Church



Dear Parish Family,

Not too long ago, our second graders from our parish and from our school together received Eucharist for the very first time. There were plenty of tears on the faces of the adults as we saw the sincerity and innocence of our children meet the tenderness and humility of Christ in the Eucharist.

Our recently initiated, Joe, Ariel, Jacobe, Andrew and Thomas are aglow with the joy of having received the Eucharist for the first time at Easter, and of now having the privilege to receive Him again and again and again until they one day see him face-to-face in glory. The proper name for the period they are in right now is Mystagogia, a Latin term that could basically be translated as "afterglow," the blessed time of joy and thankfulness that follows the explosion of fresh faith into their lives.

During this period of Mystagogia, the newly initiated candidates have expressed a desire to learn how to share their experience in the Eucharist with people who are not Catholic and do not understand our passionate relationship with the sacrament. They are trying to find a way to express the paradox that the bread and wine continue to look like bread and wine, even though through the miracle of the consecration, they have actually become the body and blood of Jesus Christ... containing his soul and divinity within them.

Without careful reflection and skillfully choosing our words, we could actually inadvertently give people the wrong impression about what we believe about the Eucharist. On the one side, we could speak about it as if it were only a symbol, which can't express the full power it has as a vehicle for Christ's body and blood, soul and divinity. On the other extreme, we could accidentally make it sound like some crude form of cannibalism that would cause a reasonable person to recoil.

The real skill is to learn to speak about these things in a way that is true to the richness of the mystery, while still being easy enough for a child to understand. This Holy Week I was reflecting on the words to the ancient Catholic hymn "Tantum ergo," which masterfully expresses what we believe about the Eucharist in such simple, yet rich terms.

- Tantum ergo Sacramentum: Down in adoration falling,
- **veneremur cernui:** this great Sacrament we hail.
- **Et antiquum documentum:** Over ancient forms of worship
- **novo cedat ritui:** this new rite of grace prevails.
- Praestet fides supplementum: Faith will tell us Christ is present
- **sensuum defectui**: where our feeble senses fail.

What could be simpler? Our senses are limited, but our faith is not. Let us join our children and our RCIA candidates in their "afterglow" as we thank God for a gift as great as the Eucharist.


